Approval system

- Providers will initially need advance approval with a minimum of ten sessions (provisional provider status)
- Then, they'll be eligible for an upgrade to full provider status
- Full providers will not need to seek approval from the GOC
- All active current providers will be grandfathered into 'full provider status'

Those with full provider status will have...

- Increased freedom to set own curricula (within boundaries of domains)
- More flexibility around designating who content is suitable for
- Ability to set points available for sessions
- No fast-track fees to pay!



Guidance for providers

- Intended to replace current 'CET Principles and Requirements' document
- Includes information for new and current providers
- High-level to reflect greater freedom of new scheme and avoid prescription
- New 'Standards for Providers' included to be clear about our expectations

Guidance for providers (2)
