# UPDATED NOTICE OF INQUIRY SUBSTANTIVE HEARING

Take notice that an inquiry will be conducted in the above matter by the Fitness to Practise Committee of the General Optical Council.

A substantive hearing will be proceeding:

#### Remotely

The substantive hearing will take place from **9:30am** on **Monday 05 February to Thursday 15 February 2024** by way of video conference or telephone conference facilities.

The Inquiry will be based upon the allegation submitted by the Council (see below) and will determine whether the fitness to practise of **Naveed Ahmed** is impaired by virtue of the provisions contained in section 13D(2) of the Opticians Act 1989.

The Committee's powers of disposal are set out in sections 13F to 13I.

#### **ALLEGATION**

### The case against Naveed Ahmed:

The Council alleges that in relation to you, Mr Naveed Ahmed (01-28635), a registered Optometrist, whilst you were working at Specsavers [REDACTED] as a locum optometrist:

- 1) On 4 April 2018, between around 8.52am and around 4.41pm you conducted eye examinations on the patients listed in Schedule A.
- 2) You failed to allow sufficient time to conduct adequate and/or complete examinations on some or all of the patients listed in Schedule A.
- 3) On 4 April 2018, you conducted eye examinations in around 7 minutes or less for some or all of the following 25 patients listed in Schedule A:
  - a. Patient 1
  - b. Patient 4
  - c. Patient 6
  - d. Patient 7
  - e. Patient 8
  - f. Patient 12
  - g. Patient 13
  - h. Patient 14
  - i. Patient 15
  - j. Patient 16
  - k. Patient 18
  - I. Patient 19
  - m. Patient 20
  - n. Patient 21
  - o. Patient 22
  - p. Patient 23
  - q. Patient 24
  - r. Patient 27
  - s. Patient 31
  - t. Patient 32
  - u. Patient 35

- 4) The eye examinations you conducted for some or all of the patients listed in Allegation 3 were incomplete and/or performed to an inadequate standard.

- 5) On 4 April 2018, you conducted eye examinations for some or all of the following patients listed in Schedule A, that were either incomplete and/or performed to an inadequate standard:
  - a. Patient 2
  - b. Patient 3
  - c. Patient 5
  - d. Patient 9
  - e. Patient 10
  - f. Patient 17
  - g. Patient 25
  - h. Patient 28
  - Patient 29
  - i. Patient 30
  - k. Patient 33
- 6) On 4 April 2018, you failed to reach an adequate standard in performing eye examinations in that you:
  - a. Re Patient 8 who presented with altered vision:
    - i. failed to arrange, or record the arrangement of, repeat testing;
    - ii. failed to explore further the Patient 8's altered vision or to record that exploration;
    - iii. failed to arrange any further assessment of patient 8 apart from a 24-month recall;
  - b. Re Patient 16 failed to arrange any further check or follow-up for their reduced visual acuity:
  - c. Re Patient 36:
    - i. undertook a cover test when one was not clinically indicated;
    - ii. recorded normal pupil reactions when the patient had sight in only one eye;
    - iii. failed to check the visual acuity in the sighted eye with a pinhole;
    - iv. wrongly recorded the patient as having an intraocular lens;
- 7) On 4 April 2018 you had the following patient records open under your Socrates login:
  - a. Patient 26 from 14.06 to 14.39;
  - b. Patient 29 from 14.13 to 14.50;
  - c. Patient 30 from 14.17 to 14.54
  - d. Patient 27 from 14.24 to 14.31
  - e. Patient 28 from 14.39 to 14.47
- 8) You knew the records for Patients 26 and/or 29 and/or 30 were open at times you were not assessing the patient.

- 9) Your intention in having the records for Patients 26, and/or 27 and/or 30 open was to exaggerate the amount of time you spent assessing the patients.
- 10) Your action in paragraphs 7 to 9 were dishonest.
- 11)On 4 April 2018 you had the following patient records open under your Socrates login:
  - a. Patient 37 from 09.07 to 09.38;
  - b. Patient 2 from 09.18 to 09.29;
- 12) You knew the record for Patient 37 was open at times you were not assessing the patient.
- 13) Your intention in having the record for Patients 37 open was to exaggerate the amount of time you spent assessing the patient.
- 14) Your action in paragraphs 11 to 13 were dishonest.
- 15)On 4 April 2018, you failed to adequately and/or appropriately supervise the eye examinations carried out by Registrant B, for some or all of the patients listed in Schedule B:
- 16)On 4 April 2018, you failed to adequately and/or appropriately supervise the eye examination of Patient 21 listed in Schedule B, in that you failed to ensure that a visual field test was undertaken or recorded:

And by virtue of the facts set out above, your fitness to practise is impaired by reason of misconduct.
